REGIONAL TACIS SEMINAR IN KALININGRAD

On the 25th of April the Informational-practical seminar for the TACIS projects approved under the Lithuania, Poland and Kaliningrad Region of Russian Federation Neighbourhood Programme took place in Kaliningrad, attended by more than 60 people.

The seminar was organised as an idea of the EC Delegation to Russia. The TACIS Local Support Office in Kaliningrad and the INTERREG Joint Technical Secretariat took care of the organisation of the event. Apart from the project implementers, representatives of the EC delegation to Russia and the Kaliningrad regional authorities participated in the seminar. They all discussed the contribution of the EU technical assistance to the economic,

ecological and social development of Kaliningrad oblast. Representatives of the EC Delegation to Russia and the regional ministries of international relations, finance, local-government and industry (tourism department) instructed the project implementers on various requirements of the EU and the Russian government.

A representative of the Polish ministry of the regional development – the acting National Authority in the Lithuania, Poland and Kaliningrad Region of Russian Federation Neighbourhood Programme, Pawel Natkaniec also took part in the seminar.
