The public entity INTERREG Joint Technical Secretariat, established by the Lithuanian Ministry of the Interior, has changed its name. The new name of the entity is: public entity Joint Technical Secretariat.

The new name is valid from 21 January, 2008 when the new statute of the public

entity had been registered in the Lithuanian register of legal entities.

The other data of the public entity (address, legal entity number, VAT payer's code) remain unchanged after the change of the name.
