Amounts of European Union part-financing in Lithuanian municipalities, Polish counties and Russian districts

The INTERREG Joint Technical Secretariat has made calculations of how the ERDF part-funding and the TACIS part-funding was allocated to the Lithuanian municipalities, Polish counties and Russian districts. The statistics, including both finally approved and not-finally approved projects, shows that the largest amount of EU assistance should come to Alytus city – 2,64 million euros, 2,15 million euros has been allocated to Kaliningrad

district, Goldapski county has attracted 2,12 million euro to their region, Klaipeda city – 1,78 million euro and Suwalki city – 1,76 million euro.

When measuring the amounts of the EU assistance to the regional and local units of the Programme territory, projects benefiting the whole Lithuanian county or Polish voivodeship were counted separately. That is why units like Alytus county or Warminsko-mazurskie voivodeship appear on the list.

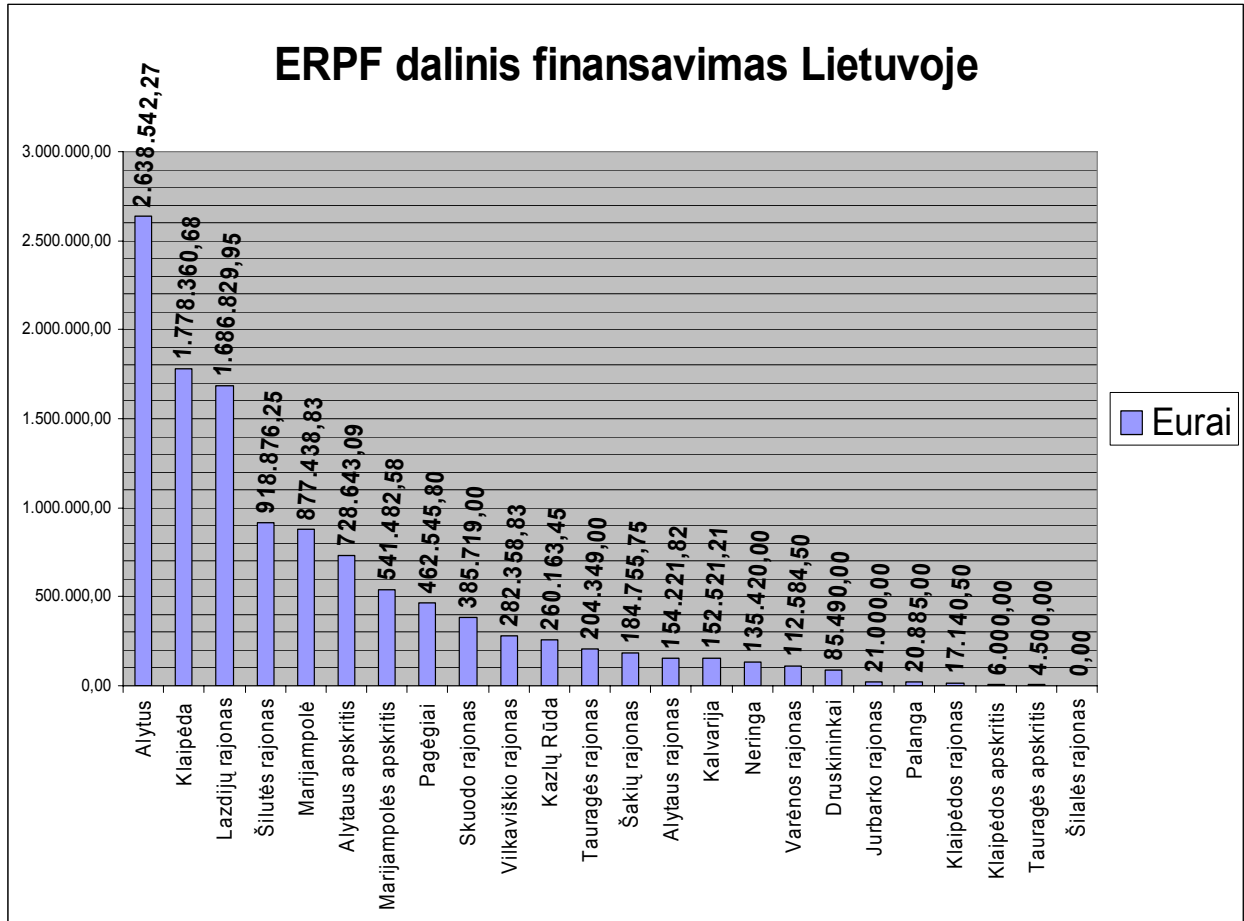

Projects submitted by the County governors' administrations, Alytus and Marijampole firebrigades, as well as Euroregion "Nemunas" Marijampole

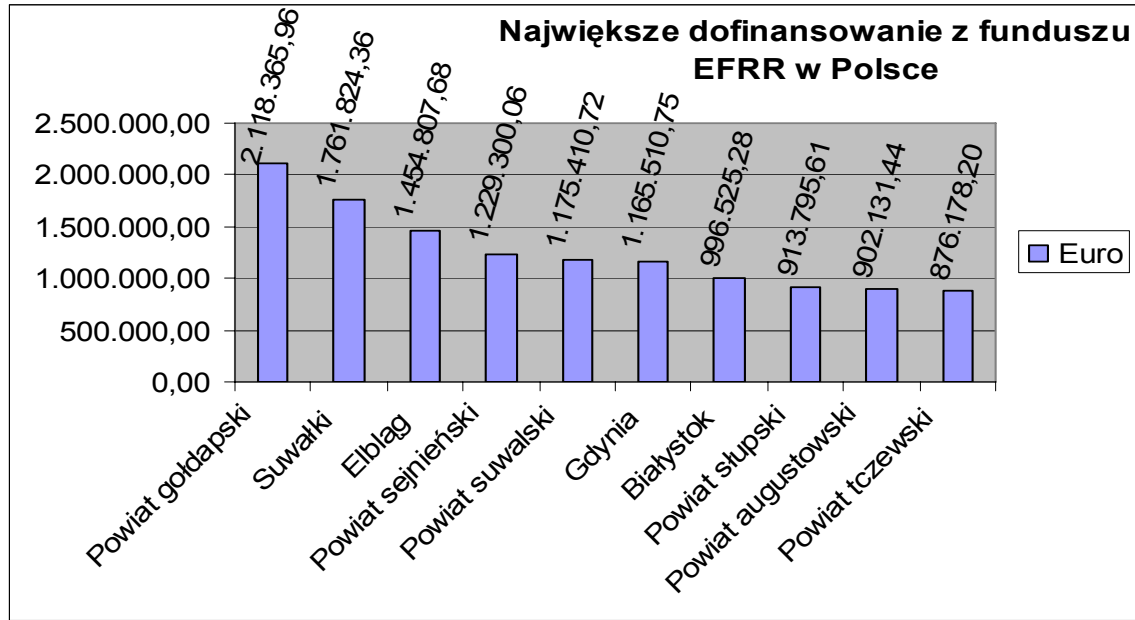

benefiting the whole voivodeship and thus come under the units of voivodeships.

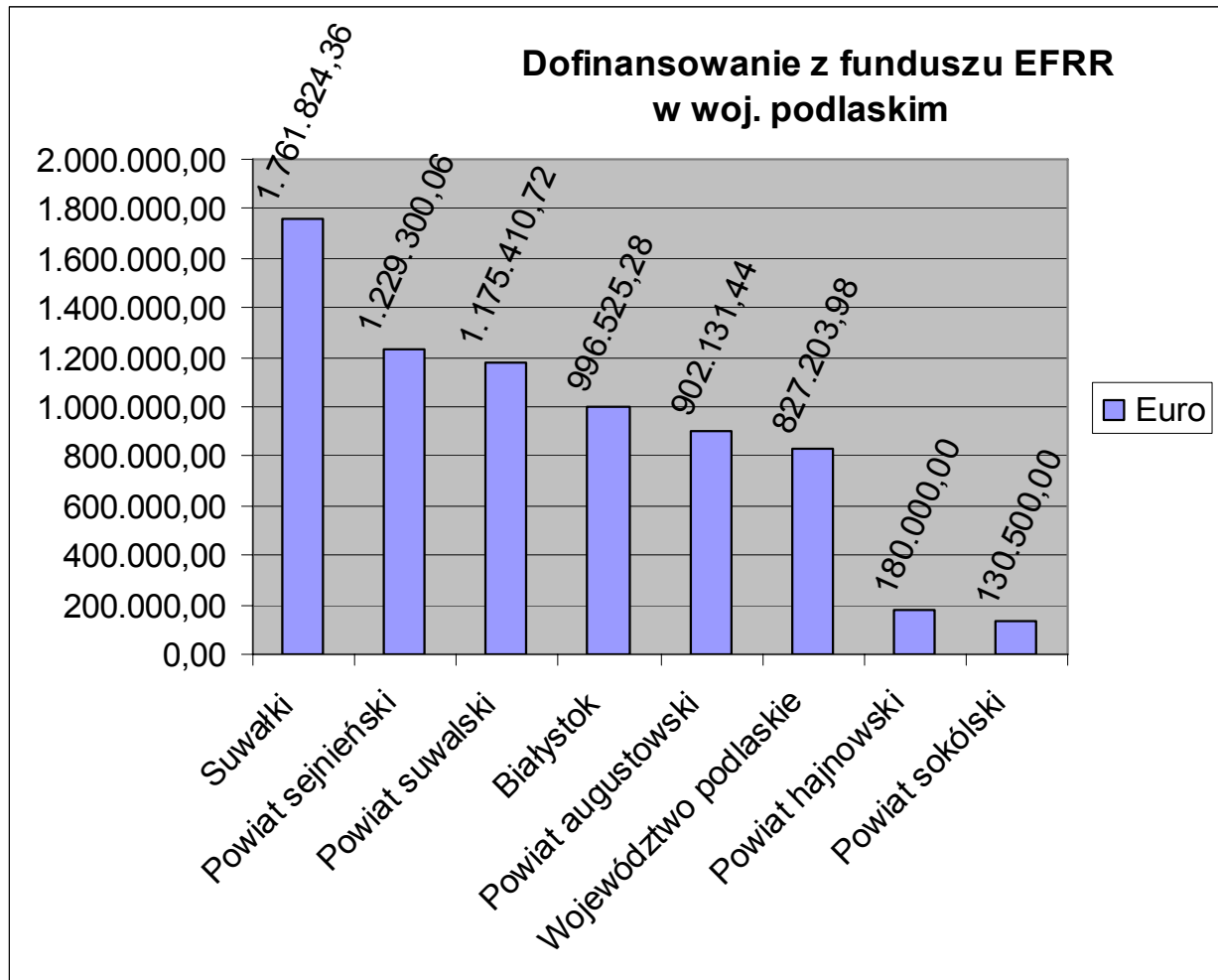

In Podlaskie voivodeship, beneficiaries from the gminas of Sejny and Pusk represent Sejnienski county,

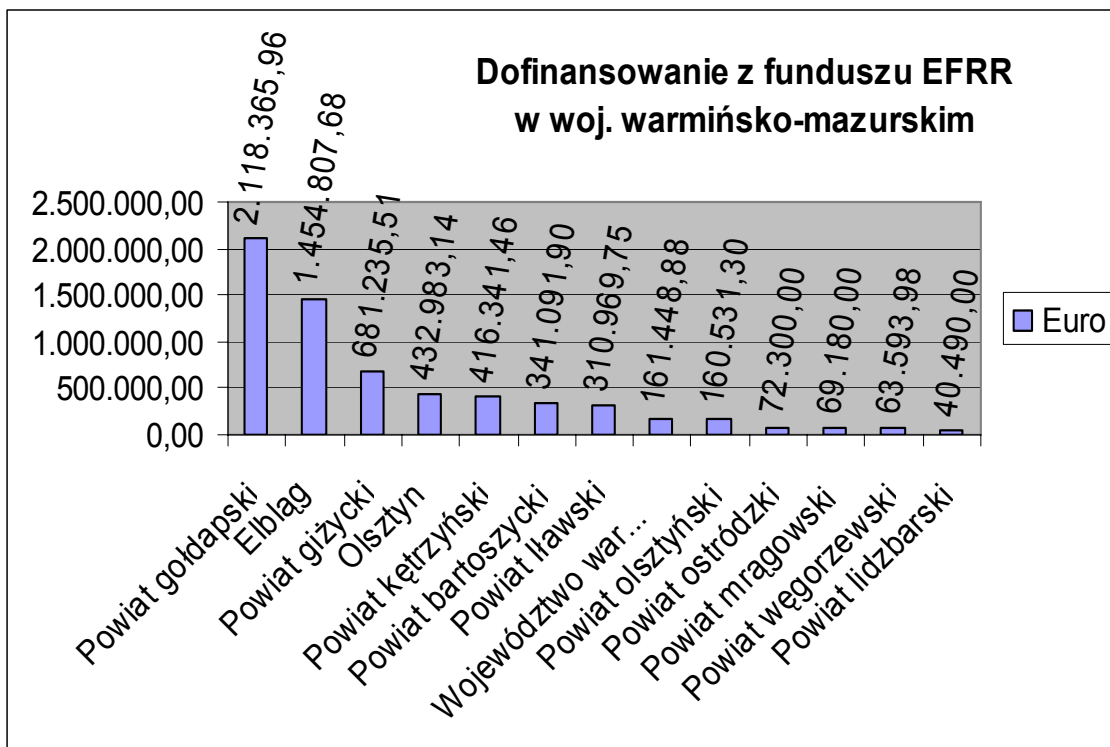
beneficiaries from the gminas of Rutka-Tartak, Wizajny and Szypliszki come under Suwalski county.

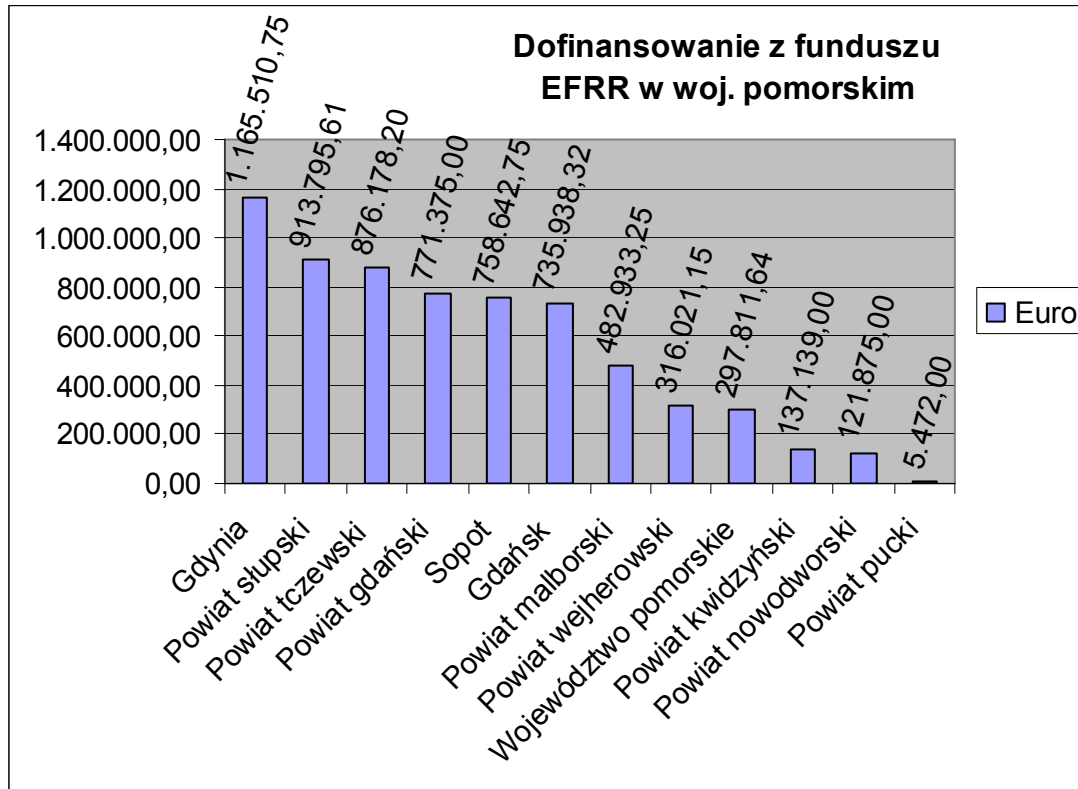
and Srokowo are counted as Ketrzynski county, Biskupiec and Wegajty are presented as Olsztyński county, Ilawski county stands for gminas of Ilawa, Jerzwald and Susz, and Mragowski county represents one beneficiary from Sorkwity.

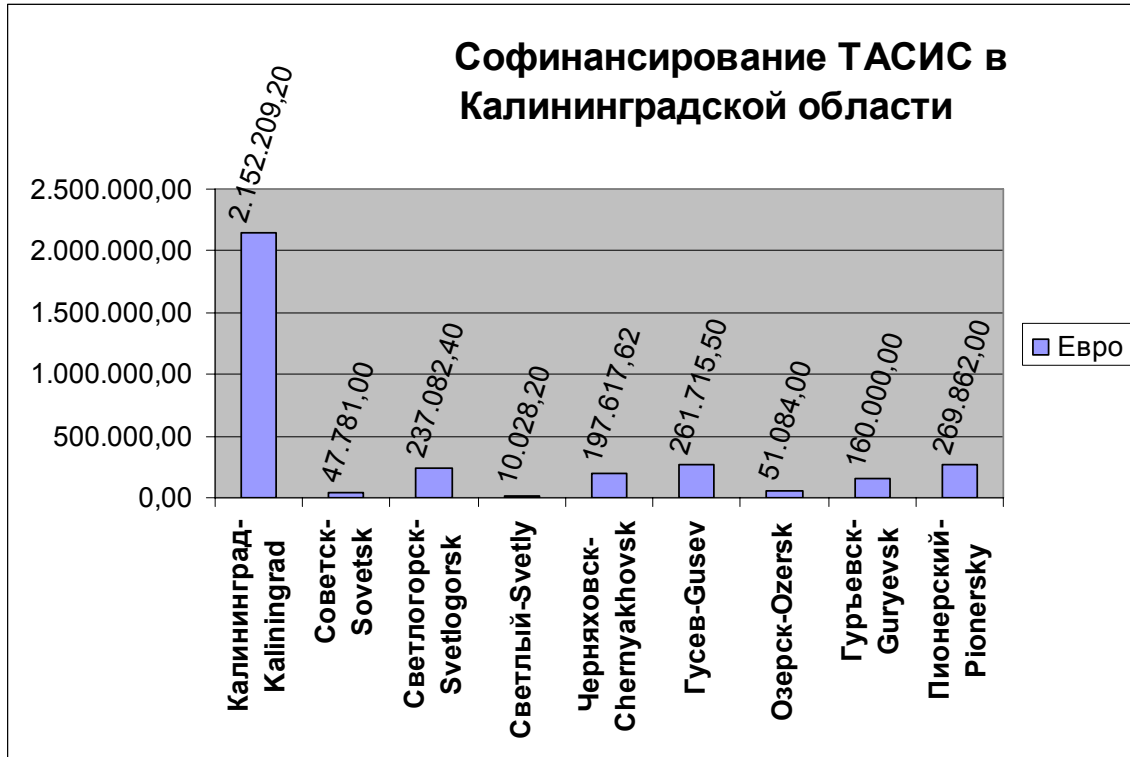
from gmina Kosakowo, Słupski county stands for the only beneficiary from Ustka and Nowodworski county represents gmina of Krynica Morska.
